

Who We Are

Homecoming 250 Navy Marine Corps is a 501(c)(3) charitable organization dedicated to bringing the celebration of the U.S. Navy and U.S. Marine Corps 250th birthdays to their birthplace - Philadelphia and the Delaware River. The Navy and Marine Corps were created in Independence Hall and Congress Hall, organized at Tun Tavern, and launched their first ships and amphibious missions from the Delaware in Fall 1775. There is no better place to celebrate their 250th anniversaries.

Homecoming 250[™] has won tremendous support. The Secretary of the Navy has directed the Navy and Marine Corps to celebrate the Navy and Marine Corps 250th in Philadelphia and Camden in 2025. The Navy and Marine Corps held a preparatory Navy and Marine Corps Week in both cities in October 2023. Homecoming 250 is honored to serve as the charitable coordinating body working with the Armed Services and cities.

This amazing celebration will be the grand opening event of America's Semiguincentennial and likely the biggest event honoring those who have served our Country.
